**Day #1** Write a paragraph on "What is the Bible." What do we believe, how do we know? (This will be done in Confirmation Class) **Pray for 2-3 minutes.**

**Day #2** Read *Genesis* 12:1-7, 17:1-7. What do these passages tell you about our God? How does God communicate with people? What promise did God make to Abram? What was Abram/Abraham's response?  
**Using the back of this sheet of paper, write out your own prayer that you could use this week.**  
**Pray for 2-3 minutes.**

**Day #3** Read *I Kings* 19:8-13  
Once again, using your journal to write your thoughts about what these scriptures say about God. How do we know who God is?  
**Pray for 2-3 minutes.**

**Day #4** How was "See You At the Pole"? Who lead the prayer at your school? Who was there? In what ways did you see God through that event/During the week at school, home or other places?

Read Isaiah 6:1-8. What are the angels doing? What are some names for angels used here? What does this passage tell us about God?

**Pray for 2-3 minutes.**

**Day #5** Read Isaiah 40:12-18. Luke 15:4-7. John 1:1-5, 16-18, John 4:24 and I John 4:7-10

Write in your journal what it means to worship God. Why worship God?

**Pray for 2-3 minutes.**

**Day #6** This is your final day before your Sabbath. The Hebrews were instructed to gather twice as much food as they needed for one day, so that they could rest on the next day. Today you'll be "gathering enough 'spiritual' food so that you'll have enough for tomorrow" too! Choose 6 out of the 10 to look up. Write down all the names or characteristics for God, that you find.

Read Psalm 18:2, Genesis 18:25, I John 2:20, Psalm 23:1, Revelation 1:8, John 14:16, Psalm 36:9, I John 4:8, 2 Samuel 22:3, 2 Corinthians 1:3...

**Extra Credit:** Isaiah 6:5, Luke 11:2, Romans 8:15, Exodus 3:14, Isaiah 66:13, Isaiah 40:28.

**Pray for 2-3 minutes.**

**Day #7** It is your day of rest given to you by God to do whatever you want to get to know Him better—enjoy it!!!
